## 2012 Scholarship Competition

**Eligibility:** Piano students who demonstrate outstanding piano talent and progress while pursuing excellence in performance. Previous 1st prize winners may not compete again in the same age group. Contestants should not be relatives or students of judges, artistic advisors, Steinway Society board members or employees of Jacobs Music.

**Deadline:** **Applications must be delivered or postmarked by February 27, 2012.**  
Late applications will not be accepted.

**Entrance Fee:** Payable to Steinway Society\*

Group 1: Age 7-9 (min. 2 years of study)	\$40
Group 2: Age 10-12	\$45
Group 3: Age 13-15	\$50
Group 4: Age 16-18	\$55

\*Fee may be waived in cases of financial hardship.

**Preliminary Audition:** Submit an application along with an audio CD of two contrasting works from different historical periods along with the application fee. Include a brief biographical statement and a teacher recommendation. All CDs will be heard anonymously and evaluated for musicality and technique by a panel of pianists qualified in the field of pedagogy and performance.

**Final Audition:** On April 7, 2012 at Jacobs Music, three judges will audition the finalists who will perform from memory two contrasting solo pieces. The names and qualifications of the judges will be posted on the Steinway Society website: <http://www.steinwaysocietyprinceton.org>  
Please provide an original score of each piece (no photocopies) for use by the judges. Judges reserve the right not to award scholarships in all categories; their decisions will be final. Winner placements will be announced after each group.

**Awards Recital:** Winners will perform one piece and receive their awards during the Scholarship Musicale on April 29, 2012 at the Mayo Concert Hall of College of New Jersey. Photographs will be taken following the recital. Having participated as a winner, you consent to the use of your name and photograph in connection with Steinway Society publicity.
